## Sweepstakes- Prizes and Awards as specified below

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. NO SPECTATORS DURING JUDGING!
- 2. This department is open to all flowers and plants grown in San Benito County by non-commercial growers. All flowers and plants must have been grown by exhibitors except for the arrangement classes. Flowers and foliage in arrangements and gardens may be purchased. Persons wishing to enter any plants or flowers will do so by filling out an entry form. Exhibitor must name variety of flower or plant on entry form.

This department is also open to San Benito County commercial florists who may enter into the specific divisions. Flowers used by commercial florists do not need to be grown in San Benito County. Commercial arraignments are displayed and not judged, they will receive a participation ribbon. Commercial exhibitors must enter under the business name and may include a business card with the arrangement.

- 3. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the right card with the right entry. Management is not responsible for errors.
- 4. Judges may reserve the right to award 1st, 2nd, 3rd or no place if, in their judgment, the exhibitor is not meritorious of a higher award.
- 5. Exhibits must be adequately and correctly labeled.
- 6. Glass bottles will be supplied by the department for the display of cut flowers.
- 7. Accessories, where allowed, must be in scale to the plant or container. Accessories that are larger/wider than the plant or container will not be allowed to exhibit.
- 8. All arrangements are to be made by exhibitor. Exhibitors 5 years of age and under may receive minimal guidance.

## 9. Sweepstakes will be awarded as specified below:

- a. First award, 5 points; Second award, 3 points; Third award, 1 point
- b. A minimum of 3 separate exhibitors have achieved a combined point total of 30 points
- c. To receive sweepstakes awards, an exhibitor must have a minimum of ten points.
