A \$6.00 Office Fee and a \$6.00 Ground Fee must be paid once per exhibitor. A \$5.00 Drug Fee is required for each horse entered.

One 4-H High Point Award (classes 13 & 14)

One FFA High Point Award (classes 14)

***NEW*Ranch Horse High point (classes 6, 15)**

Per exhibitor combination calculated as follows:

1st: 5pts 2nd: 4pts 3rd: 3pts 4th: 2pts 5th: 1pt

Ties are broken by most firsts (if necessary 2^{nds}, then 3^{rds})

4-H / FFA Specific Rules and Regulations: (Please read carefully)

Open to San Benito, Monterey, Santa Clara and Santa Cruz Counties only. This is a State Qualifying Show.

Rules and Regulations:

1. All horses owned or leased, must be in exhibitors' name at least 120 days prior to San Benito County Fair. See State Rules regarding ownership. 4H/FFA Must show ownership papers and notarized lease papers at check in.
2. Exhibitor must be a member in good standing of a 4-H or FFA Horse Project.
3. The official 4-H and FFA show uniform to be worn by all exhibitors while showing at the Horse Show. Uniform consists of hard hat or helmet, white shirt or blouse (long or short sleeve), and white or black pants which are to the ankles. FFA uniform to include the FFA Jacket. **ABSOLUTELY NO MIDRIFF OR SLEEVELESS SHIRTS OR ACID WASH PANTS.** Only exception: English classes may wear English attire if pants are white or black in color. If pants have belt loop, belt must be worn. No other equipment necessary except appropriate clean saddle and bridle.
3. First and Second Place in Division 141: Classes 1, 2 and 4 MAY advance to next Showmanship level.
4. First Place in Division 141: Classes 2, 3 and 5 are eligible to participate in the Fair's Round Robin on Sun. Oct 6. These winners MUST sign up immediately at the Sign in Desk. Should First place winner decide NOT to participate, second place will be given the opportunity.
5. While at the Fair, 4-H and FFA members are expected to groom their animals themselves. Adult help in handling, preparing or caring for the animal, except for safety reasons, may cause the member and/or animal to be disqualified. (Disqualification consists of withholding ribbons,

elimination from further competition, and/or removal from the grounds.)

6. Pre-entry of Showmanship is MANDATORY. NO entry fees.

7. Stallions are not eligible for any 4-H / FFA class.

Rules and Regulations applicable to everyone.

1. Exhibitor's age as of Jan. 1, 2019.
2. State Rules I through V, State Horse Show Rules X1 through 26, Equine Health Rules and All Local Rules apply to this Department.
3. One exhibitor per entry form. Please print unless stated otherwise. Forms may be photocopied. Exhibitor must have required releases signed before participation.
4. **Show MANAGER reserves the right to combine or cancel classes. Show MANAGER reserves the right to cancel a class if there are 3 or less entries.**
5. Show Manager reserves the right to disqualify or excuse any exhibitor, rider, groom or horse showing discourtesy, disobedience or dangerous actions without being liable for compensation. Disqualification forfeits all awards. This rule includes junior entries exhibiting unsafe or incompetent actions.
6. SHOW MANAGER AND JUDGES' DECISION FINAL!!
7. Vet certificate required if substituting any horse for any class.
8. Protest – refer to State Rules.
9. NUMBER MUST BE WORN ON EXHIBITOR'S BACK.
11. Show to follow USEF RULES unless otherwise stated.
11. No stallions to be handled or shown by anyone under the age of 18.
12. Registered breed class entries must include a photocopy of current registration papers with entry forms. Only major breed associations/clubs will be recognized (AQHA, APHA, AMHA, IAHA, APHC, etc.). The horse does NOT have to be owned by the exhibitor. The listed registered owner will be noted.
13. Grade/purebred breeds are animals that are NOT currently registered and CANNOT be registered with a major breed association/club.
14. There will be a 10-minute break to tack up between the end of Division 142 and the start of Division 143.
15. Helmets are encouraged to be worn by all participants, required for 4-H / FFA participants.
16. Leadline entries may NOT show in any other riding class. Exhibitor must be led by a competent adult. Safety is a priority.
17. 10 and under entrants (class 10) may NOT enter any 13 and under events (class 11) or any riding classes that required a CANTER or LOPE. ANY class for 14 and over MAY BE required to Lope or Canter.
18. Exhibitors MUST be at the gate when their class is called. Judge will not hold the gate for a participant who is not there. Please be ready.
19. Warm-up area will be available.
20. Obstacles and courses set up for use during show are OFF-LIMITS until the division/class has been judged.
21. Classes can be combined or cancelled at Show Manager's discretion.
22. No Dogs except Service Dogs allowed on the fairgrounds. No exceptions.
