One entry per event unless otherwise noted.

**NO POST ENTRIES ARE PERMITTED IN THE JUNIOR RODEO.**

Rules:

1. National high school rodeo association rules are only used as a guide; the San Benito County Fair Rodeo committee reserves the right to apply rules accordingly to circumstances.

2. All around points are awarded 1st thru 10th place only. No all-around points for Junior/Senior team roping, Mutton Busting & Pee Wee events.

3. Ties: in the event of a tie for any awards including all-around and reserve all-around, a flip of the coin will decide the winner.

4. Pee Wee check in 7:00-7:30a.m., Ground rules to follow

**4. Mandatory Ground Rules immediately approx. 7:30a.m. following the pee-wee check in by track entrance (north end).**

5. Arena starts at 8:00am with Barrel Race 14-18; Track starts at 8:30 with Pole Bending 14-18; Pee Wee events start at 8:00am at south end track.

6. DRESS CODE: Western attire: cowboy hat or protective headgear; long-sleeve, buttoned-up, collared shirt; cowboy boots and belt are required in all events, including Pee Wee. Bare midriffs, shorts and/or similar attire will not be tolerated. Dress code in effect to pick-up awards.

7. Contestants caught drinking alcohol, using drugs, using inappropriate language or abusive treatment of livestock will be disqualified. This is a drug and alcohol-free area; smoking is not permitted.

8. Contestants and parents are not allowed to talk to the arena or track judges, unless requested by the judge. If a problem arises please see the arena or track director.

9. Helpers are not allowed past the gate for ages 9-18 in all events. 8 & under contestants can have a helper to enter the track or arena. If helper crosses the start/finish line it will result in a no-time. If a helper chooses to lead an 8 & under contestant thru the event, they may, but will have 30 seconds added to their time and will not be able to win an event over a non leadline.

10. Only one helper allowed for the 4/5 pee wee age group. Only TWO helpers are allowed for the 3 and under pee wee age group.

11. All 8 and under events take place in the back arena.

**12. All contestants in all events (excluding rough stock) have 60 seconds to enter the gate from the first time they are called to report.**

13. All events are open to all counties.

14. Arena takes precedence over the track.

15. Age you are as of Jan. 1, 2019 determines the age category you will compete in.

16. Only siblings can ride the same horse as another rider in the same division except barrels & pole bending. 8 & under siblings can share in all events.

17. Unless specified, both boys and girls can participate all events.

18. Any contestants needing to draw out of the rodeo must show written verification by a qualified Veterinary or Licensed Doctor, stating the date of inspection and nature of disqualification and must be filed at the fairgrounds 24 hours before the start of the rodeo, to have entry fees refunded. The office, grounds, ambulance and any stock fee will not be

refunded. Any draw outs without written verification by a qualified Veterinary or Licensed Doctor will not be refunded.

Association management (Horse Show Department) reserves the right to stop any contestant from competing when in their judgment, anyone's personal safety is in jeopardy. In general, committee will specify conditions of competition at start of each event. Their judgment and any supplemental rules, in all cases will be FINAL!!

Track and Arena events may be switched to track and/or to accommodate time schedule. ARENA JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

Junior Rodeo Rules and Regulations:

1. To qualify for ALL-AROUND AWARD, an exhibitor MUST place in more than one event.

2. Three (3) entries by three (3) or more exhibitors will constitute a minimum class. Where entries are less than for a minimum class at the close of entry, the class may be cancelled or combined. This decision will be made by management and department chairs.

3. For all roping events, the catch pen is closed.

4. All partners must be named on entry form before closing date of entries. Boy & Girl partners allowed in all team events.

5. Year and date of birth must be listed on entry form.

6. PARENT or LEGAL GUARDIAN SIGNATURE REQUIRED ON ALL ENTRIES BY CLOSING DATE OF ENTRY OR ENTRY WILL BE REJECTED.

**ONLINE ENTRY INFORMATION: Please enter your Partner's Name in the Entry Comment box and if they are the roper or the runner.**

Multiple Department numbers are only used to make sure that correct fees are charged to each contestant. Depending on which events are entered Drug and Ambulance fees may or may not have to be paid.

**DIVISION 160 PEE WEE STICK HORSE RACE**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$10.00**

Kids to line up with stick horse between legs and run around a cone and across the finish line. Judges will determine 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> places. Judge's decision is final. Must supply own stick horse. **Does not count towards all around. No payout.**

**DIVISION 161 PEE WEE BOOT RACE**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$10.00**

Kids will take off one cowboy boot. Cowboy boots will be lined up on line. Kids will run to their boot, put it on and run back to starting line. Judges will determine 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> places. **Does not count towards all around. No payout.**

**DIVISION 162 PEE WEE GOAT TAIL UNTYING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$10.00**

Kids will run across a chalk line, one at a time & pull a ribbon from a goat's tail. Fastest time wins. **Does not count towards all around. No payout.**

**All Pee Wee's must follow dress code. Only cowboy boots allowed.**

**DIVISION 163 MUTTON BUSTING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$10.00**

Longest ride wins, time stops when rider makes any contact with the ground. Must face forward on animal. Protective gear is required. Spurs prohibited. **Does not count towards all around.**

**DIVISION 164 GOAT TAIL UNTYING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$25.00**

Rider must dismount (horse required) and remove the ribbon from Goat's tail, 60 second time limit.

 1. Age 8 & under

**DIVISION 165 GIRL'S GOAT TYING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$25.00**

Rider must dismount, tie any three legs. Contestant must furnish own piggin' string. Animal must remain tied for 6 seconds, 60-second time limit.

 1. Age 9 – 13  
 2. Age 14 – 18

**DIVISION 166 BOY'S GOAT TYING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$25.00**

Rider must dismount, tie any three legs. Contestants must furnish own piggin' string. Animal must remain tied for six seconds, 60 second time limit.

 1. Age 9 – 13

**DIVISION 167 SINGLE STAKE RACE**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$20.00**

Rider must ride horse around a single stake and back across the start line. 5 second penalty for knocked pole. 60 second time limit.

 2. Age 9 - 13

**DIVISION 168 POLE BENDING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$20.00**

60 second time limit. 5 second penalty for knocked pole. Standard pole bending pattern.

 2. Age 9 - 13  
 3. Age 14 – 18

**DIVISION 169 BARREL RACE**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$20.00**

Clover leaf pattern, 5-second penalty for each barrel knocked over, 60 second time limit.

 2. Age 9 - 13  
 3. Age 14 – 18

**DIVISION 170 KEYHOLE RACE**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$20.00**

Ride horse down to keyhole from starting line, turn horse around in key-hole and run back across finish line. You are disqualified if you step OVER or ON the lines of the keyhole. 60 second time limit.

 2. Age 9 - 13

**DIVISION 171 GIRL'S BREAK-AWAY ROPING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$30.00**

Ropes to be checked by committee in barrier. Two loops, 30 second time limit. 10 second penalty for broken barrier.

Class:

- 1. Age 9 – 13
- 2. Age 14 – 18

**DIVISION 172 BOY’S BREAK-AWAY ROPING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$30.00**

Ropes to be checked by committee in barrier. Two loops, 30 second time limit. 10 second penalty for broken barrier.

Class:

- 1. Age 9 – 13

**DIVISION 173 BOY’S CALF TIE DOWN ROPING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$30.00**

Two loops, 30 second time limit. 10 second penalty for broken barrier. Calf must remain tied for 6 seconds.

- 1. Age 14 – 18

**DIVISION 174 BOY’S CHUTE DOGGING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) ..... \$30.00**

Time will start when the steers inside front shoulder passes the planes of the bucking chute. There will be line 10 feet from the chute. Steers nose must cross line before steer can be thrown. Contestant must change direction or bring steer to a stop and twist it down. Steer will be considered down when it is lying flat on its side with all 4 feet and head facing the same direction.

**DIVISION 175 STEER STOPPING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$30.00**

Two loops, 30 second time limit. 10 second penalty for broken barrier. Steer must face horse and rider.

- 2. Age 14-18

**DIVISION 176 RESCUE RACE**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$20.00**

Horse and single rider travel to designated point at end of arena where partner mounts horse. Cannot use barrel, rider must mount from the ground. Tandem riders return to starting point for time. Rider must be mounted before crossing plane of designated point. Both riders must have one leg on each side of horse. Both pay, split money, enter only once. Mixed teams not required.

**DIVISION 177 RIBBON ROPING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) ..... \$25.00**

Calf leaves chute with ribbon, roper to catch by neck only. No ropes to be tied hard and fast. Runner gets time when he pulls ribbon from calf and taken to flagger. 60 second time limit, 10 second penalty for breaking barrier. Enter only once. Both pay, split money. Mixed teams not required.

**DIVISION 178 JUNIOR/JUNIOR TEAM ROPING**

Junior partners must be 118 & under

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$25.00**

Three loops any way, three legal head catches (horns, half head or neck); 10 second penalty for breaking barrier, 5 seconds for one hind leg. 60 second time limit.

Class:

- 1. Age 18 & under

**DIVISION 179 JUNIOR/SENIOR TEAM ROPING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$25.00**

Senior member can rope once unless roping with own children; three loops any way, three legal head catches (horns, half-head or neck); 10 second penalty for breaking barrier, 5 second penalty for one back leg. 60 second time limit. **Does not count towards all around.**

- 1. Junior Partner age 18 & under and Senior partner age 19 & over

**DIVISION 180 SADDLE BRONC STEER RIDING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class) .....\$60.00**

Riders must provide their own saddle. To qualify rider must stay on for 6 seconds. Will follow high school rodeo guidelines. Buckle award to first place (no other awards),

- 1. Age 9-13

**DIVISION 181 SADDLE BRONC RIDING**

**Entry Fees: (per entry per class)..... \$60.00**

Riders must provide their own saddle. To qualify rider must stay on for 8 seconds. Will follow high school rodeo guidelines. Buckle award to first place (no other awards) **\$500.00 added to payout.**
