See LOCAL RULES & REGULATIONS, Page 7, concerning the required Still Exhibit. Failure to comply will result in DISQUALIFICATION of all Market Entries for an exhibitor.

Rules and Regulations:

1. MINIMUM WEIGHT FOR MARKET BEEF IS 1000 POUNDS. ANIMALS WEIGHING OVER THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT OF 1375 POUNDS WILL ONLY BE PAID TO 1375 POUNDS.

2. Market animals must be clipped and bathed and arrive in show condition

3. WEIGH-IN: All market beef must be weighed in between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Tue, Oct 1, 2019.

4. After weighing, market steers and market heifers may be divided into weight lots as desired by management for convenience in judging. NOTE: 4-H & FFA will be judged separately.

5. ANIMAL OWNERSHIP – See Livestock Local Rule #18 on Page 61.

6. All cattle must be bedded on shavings. **NO STRAW!**

Rules and Regulations:

1. Must be entered and shown in market, feeder or breeding classes. Open to steers, heifers and feeders.

2. Steers, heifers and feeders must have been bred and calved in San Benito County. They must be raised by a local cattle producer prior to exhibitor purchase.

3. Breeder must designate eligible for SBC Breeder's Showcase on Bill of Sale.

4. Each steer or heifer owned by exhibitor must have individual entry.

5. Must enter breeder's name on entry form.

6. All State and Local Rules apply.

7. After judging of appropriate classes, steers, feeders and heifers will be judged separately and placing will be by selection of judge.

Beef Carcass Contest Rules

The purpose of this contest is to provide added incentive for the students to continually strive to raise better quality market beef that will meet industry standards. This contest will provide the student with a carcass evaluation only.

NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO ENTRY FOR THIS CONTEST. 4-H AND FFA BEEF WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY ENTERED

\$200.00 for 1st place, \$100.00 for 2nd place and \$50.00 for 3rd place. Other award money will be divided and paid to 4th through 10th place.

1. All market beef are entered in the Carcass Contest. No live pickups.
2. All animals entered in the Carcass Contest must be shown in the market beef classes of the exhibitor's respective division. 4-H and FFA will be judged together.
3. The animals will be sold in the Junior Livestock Auction.
4. Entry in the Carcass Contest will be automatic for all animals sold through the Junior Livestock Auction.
5. All animals entered in this contest will be consigned to a packing house designated by the Fair.
6. Carcasses will be graded at the packing house by USDA graders and results compiled by department chairs assisted by Hollister FFA Department.
7. All carcasses must grade USDA Top Select or higher to be eligible for cash awards. Results will be calculated for all market beef entered.
8. Placing will be based on grid placing; ties will be broken by yield grade and quality grade.
9. The Carcass Evaluations /Awards Presentation will be held on November 12th at 6:00 p.m. in the Oak room.
10. The Carcass Contest will include a "Rate of Gain." Rate of Gain will be calculated by using the following formula. All Rate of Gain Steers will be weighed at the same time. Fair scale weight minus starting weight (at weigh-in & tag) divided by the number of days on feed equals average weight gain. Rate of gain will be ranked by the animal that highest average daily gain to the lowest.
