Closed Door Judging

Rules and Regulations:

1. No work previously hung at this Fair may be entered.
2. Entries must have been completed within the past two years.
3. Wet or inadequately framed two-dimensional work will not be accepted. Two-dimensional work MUST be securely WIRED FOR HANGING. Canvases must be FRAMED. Junior Art must be suitably framed and WIRED FOR HANGING. NO TAPE! Three-dimensional art may be exhibited within display case, on level surfaces of cases or tables, freestanding on the floor, or hung on the wall. If three-dimensional work is designed to be hung on the wall, artist must ensure the hanging mechanism is strong enough to support the work; Fair is not liable for it falling off the wall.
4. Watercolors, pastels and graphics must be framed and under glass or Plexiglas and be securely wired for hanging. NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS.
5. No clip frames/uniframes or in canvas frame will be accepted in any department.
6. MINIMUM SIZE: 8"x10" including frame. MAXIMUM SIZE: 34"x40" including frame. NO MURALS. NO EXCEPTIONS.
7. All entries must be adequately labeled with the exhibitor's name, address, telephone, division, class, title and medium on the back of work. If work is "For Sale", the price must also be given on the entry form and the piece of art. No commission will be charged. If not for sale, so state "NFS".
8. Entries must be originals (no copies). No kits.
9. The Art Department reserves the right to decline to display any entry found to violate these listed rules and regulations or found to be unsuitable for the family audience that the Fair attracts. The department also reserves the right to refuse a work considered too fragile to exhibit. The entry fee for such work will be refunded to the artist.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Age Limit: 1 through 13 years. All San Benito County Juniors are eligible to enter. Please state age on entry form.
2. **Entries will be limited to one (1) entry per person.**
3. Entries may be in any medium and must be properly matted. All entries will be mounted on construction paper only and no larger than 9" x12" including matting.
4. Exhibitor's name, age, address, name of work and type of medium, **MUST** be printed on the back of each entry.

5. NOTE: All exhibits left after 7 P.M. on Mon, Oct 7, 2019 will be left in the department at the owner's risk. If you are not able to pick up your exhibits notify the department Chair ahead of time.

6. This division is for individual entries. It is NOT for art submitted by classroom teachers on behalf of their students (see Dept. 46)
