Age 3-4- Snaffle Bit

Age 4-5- Hackmore

Age 5-6- T wo Rein

Age 6 & over- Bridle Straight up

Classes may be combined or split by management as needed

DIVISION 110 ADULT LIMITED (MODIFIED)

Entry Fee:\$40.00 per entry

Rules and Regulations:

- Not to have won 5 points in the N.R.C.H.A. or A.Q.H.A. in the last 5 years.
- Riders may not have shown down the fence more than three (3) times in their lifetime.
- Work to consist of a reining pattern and single cow work (boxing) on the end of the arena. Amount of time to be at the judge's discretion once the rider has shown control of the cow.
- Horses must be shown in equipment approved by the N.R.C.H.A.

Class:

- Adult Limited, 18 & over

DIVISION 111 STOCK HORSE

**Entry Fee:Class 2: \$60.00 per entry
.....Class 3: \$35.00 per entry**

Rules and Regulations:

- All horses must be shown in a straight up bridle
- N.R.C.H.A. Rules to apply.
- Ownership of horse is not required.
- A horse entered in Division 111, class 3 will not be eligible to enter Division 114, class 7.**

Class:

- 18 & over, Open Work Cattle. (Horse 6 years & over)

- 17 & under, Work Cattle.

DIVISION 112 HACKMORE

Entry Fee:\$60.00 per entry

Rules and Regulations:

- N.R.C.H.A. Rules to apply.
- Ownership of horse is not required.

Class:

- Open (Horses 5 years & under)

DIVISION 113 STOCK HORSE (DRY WORK ONLY)

Entry Fees:\$15.00 per entry

Rules and Regulations:

- N.R.C.H.A. Rules to apply.
- NO PAYOUT.**
- Chain curb straps allowed in class 1.
- Ownership of horse is not required.

Class:

- 18 & over, Open, Dry Work Only
- 17 & under, Dry Work Only

DIVISION 114 JUNIOR LIMITED (A MODIFIED CLASS)

Entry Fee:\$35.00 per entry

Rules and Regulations:

- Work to consist of a reining pattern and single cow work (boxing) on the end of the arena. Amount of time to be at the judge's discretion once the rider has shown control of the cow.
- Riders may not have shown down the fence more than three (3) times in their lifetime.
- Horses must be shown in equipment approved by the N.R.C.H.A. rules.
- A horse entered in Division 111, Class 3 will not be eligible to enter Division 114, class 7.**

Class:

- Junior Limited, 17 & under

DIVISION 115 RANCH WORKING COWHORSE

Entry Fee:\$60.00 per entry

Rules and Regulations:

- Open to any horse and rider except previous winner horse/rider combination.
- To work a cow as in the fence work part of an N.R.C.H.A. Class.
- Horses **MUST** be shown in equipment approved by the N.R.C.H.A.

Class:

- Ranch Working Cow Horse

DIVISION 116 RANCH WORKING COWHORSE AND ROPE

Entry Fee:\$60.00 per entry

Rules and Regulations:

- Open to any horse and rider except previous winner horse/rider combination.
- To work a cow as in the fence work part of an N.R.C.H.A. Class.
- Horses **MUST** be shown in equipment approved by the N.R.C.H.A.
- Riders are not permitted to have their ropetied onto the horn of the saddle. There is to be no dragging of the cow in roping. The exhibitor is allowed only two throws. To be a legal catch, the loop must be in front of the shoulders.
- Penalties will be assessed as follows: Three (3) points: two loops run or refusing to turn. Five (5) points: no catch run or any blatant disobedience for a circumstance not listed. No score - 0: equipment failure, rope falls off the saddle or failure to compete cow work segment
- If time and number of cattle permit, the judge may, at his discretion, award new cattle, to enable the contestant to show his horse's ability on the cow, based on the following criteria: the cow won't or can't run; the cow won't leave the end of the arena; the cow is blind or won't yield to the horse; or the cow leaves the arena.

Class:

- Ranch Working Cow Horse and Rope
