*This is a **MOCK** exhibition show for 2019. It will be run like an **ARBA** show, however, there will not be **ARBA** points awarded. There will not be an **ARBA** judge present this year.*

**Rules & Regulations**

Rules definitions and judging procedures as described in the latest edition of the Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. shall apply to all districts and county rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture. American Rabbit Breeders Association, Eric Stewart, Executive Director. P.O.Box 400, Knox, Pennsylvania 16232. San Benito County Fair rules may supersede A.R.B.A. rules where matters of policy or procedures are involved.

**A.R.B.A. age rule does apply.** All State and Local Rules apply.

1. Arrival October 2, 2019 between 4:00p.m.-7:00p.m
2. Exhibitors choice to coop in for duration or carry home after judging. If cooped in, must provide feed and needed supplies.
3. Absolutely no ear tagging permitted on the fairgrounds.
4. **Limit:** (2) entries per class, per division, per exhibitor.
5. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper division & class for breed, variety, age, & sex ONLY. Cavies absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.
6. This is a one day carry in show. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to and from the show table for judging and must be present when their animal is judged.
7. The San Benito County Fair is not responsible for loss, death, or injury of any animals. All possible care will be taken to protect all animals.
8. All classes will be judged to correspond with the A.R.B.A. STANDARD OF PERFECTION.
9. Cavies must be owned by the exhibitor for 30 days. The official ownership date is the date shown on the receipt of sale unless the exhibitor bred the animal.
10. Open to 4-H and FFA members and to independent juniors who meet the local 4-H or FFA specifications for entry in this department. 4-H and FFA exhibitors must be deemed eligible by leader signature.
11. Juniors must abide by "Cavy Department General Rules," unless otherwise stated.
12. All FFA and 4-H exhibitors must be in official uniform at the time of showing and must bring their own animal to the show table. Contact chair concerning time conflicts. Independent exhibitors see uniform requirements.
13. The class number is determined by age and sex of animal.
14. Important: Please consult an American Rabbit Breeder's Standard of Perfection for information concerning varieties and appropriate weights for the class in each breed.
15. The scales used for determination of weight are to be provided by the San Benito County Fair only.

Class:

1. Senior Boar-Over 6 months of age and over 32 ozs
2. Senior Sow-Over 6 months of age over 32 ozs
3. Intermediate Boar- Over 22 ozs up to & including 32 ozs up to 6 months.
4. Intermediate Sow- Over 22 ozs up to & including 32 ozs up to 6 months.
5. Junior Boar-M in weight of 12 ozs & Max weight of 22 ozs up to 6 months.
6. Junior Sow- M in weight of 12 ozs & Max weigh of 22 ozs up to 6 months

**DIVISION 014 CAVY SHOWMANSHIP**

1. Only one entry per exhibitor may be entered for showmanship class, and that animal must be entered in the Junior Cavy breed show at the 2019 Fair.
2. Animals shown in showmanship must be owned, entered and shown by the exhibitor in a cavy division to be eligible, under the provisions of the **State Rule Section VII, Rule 30**.
3. Each exhibitor will be judged individually by the judge through standard showmanship procedure.
4. Exhibitors must be in complete 4-H/FFA uniform to compete in showmanship. See requirement for uniform in this handbook under General Information.
5. Judging tables and rugs are provided.
6. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping his/her animal under control at all times.
7. Age requirements as noted.
