

San Benito County Fair - Junior Livestock CERTIFICATE OF ANIMAL MEDICATION

Every market animal exhibitor at the San Benito County Fair **MUST** properly complete and sign the Certificate of Animal Medication in order to be eligible to sell at the SBC Fair Junior Livestock Auction. This medication form covers from date of recorded ownership to last day of the Fair, October 2, 2022.

UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY, WE THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT:

- 1. NO UNAUTHORIZED CHEMICALS HAVE BEEN USED WHICH WOULD CAUSE THE CARCASS TO FAIL USDA AND FOOD & DRUG ADMINISTRATION TESTING; AND
- 2. THE WITHDRAWAL TIME REQUIRED OF ANY MEDICATION (IN-CLUDING MEDICATED FEED) OR PESTICIDE ADMINISTRATION HAS BEEN ADHERED TO.

As the owner and/or parent/legal guardian of owner of this market animal, we acknowledge that we will be responsible for the exhibited animal if it is rejected at a processing center due to the presence of DRUG RESIDUE or if it TESTS POSITIVE from random drug testing conducted at the San Benito County Fair. We understand that if drug residue is detected in the carcass, we may forfeit all proceeds from the sale of the animal, we will also incur a Civil Penalty of \$100 and an administrative fee to San Benito County Fair JLA for processing, shipping and other expenses to be determined by actual cost. We understand we also may also be liable for attorney's fees.
